Virtual Symposium: Overview

California continues to face a homelessness and housing crisis on a scale never seen. **The Evidence-Based Practices 2020 Symposium** is focused on practices and strategies that have demonstrated effectiveness for working with adults, children, and families with behavioral health challenges who concurrently experience homelessness or housing insecurity. Day 1: Keynote Bios

Dr. Sam Tsemberis (clinical psychologist) developed the HOUSING FIRST program (HF) that effectively ends homelessness for individuals, families, and youth. The program has been implemented across the US, Canada, many EU countries, Australia, and NZ. Dr. Tsemberis currently serves as the CEO of the Pathways HOUSING FIRST Institute providing consultation and technical assistance across the globe issues on homelessness, mental health, and addiction.

Margot Kushel, MD is a Professor of Medicine at University of California San Francisco, and Director of the UCSF Center for Vulnerable Populations, and the UCSF Benioff Homelessness and Housing Initiative. She is a practicing general internist at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital. Margot's research focuses on the causes and consequences of homelessness and housing instability, with the goal of preventing and ending homelessness and ameliorating the effects of homelessness on health. She speaks at a local, state and national level about issues of homelessness, and provides testimony to legislative bodies. She received her AB from Harvard College, her MD from Yale and completed residency, chief residency and fellowship in internal medicine at UCSF.
