# Stigma Today: Straw Poll



Mental Illness: A Snapshot • 1 in 5 adults and 1 in 7 children (6-17) experience mental illness: 2020

- **53.8%** of adults were not in treatment: 2020
- 1 person dies by suicide every 11 seconds
- Global mental health spending: 2% of total health
- Life expectancy difference: 10-20 years



80% (N=391, 45 countries) of people with lived experience agreed:

"Stigma and discrimination can be worse than the impact of the mental health condition itself"

Stigma directly:

- Increases suicide rates
- Reduces help-seeking and recovery success

"I felt so much shame, so weighed down by the stigma, that I couldn't function." –Andy Dunn

#### Impacts of Stigma



Stigma Kills and Violates Human Rights



The consequences of stigma violate basic human rights eg, reduced job and education opportunities and access to health care, including mental health care
